CFE Tool of the Month

Connectedness Mapping is part of the Family Finding Model. It is a quick and easy tool that uses simple shapes and lines to illustrate a person's connections (or lack of connections).

This tool can also establish a visually compelling image of loneliness for young people separated from consistent adult relationships over time, stemming from multiple moves in and out of home care as well as long-term separation from family members.

Connectedness Map can be viewed as less intrusive than mobility mapping. Using the Connectedness Map may help the child avoid recalling traumatic events from the past that may surface during mobility mapping.


Connectedness Mapping can be accomplished by using the CFE APP or by using a blank piece of paper with red, green, blue, and yellow marker or crayons.

Red represents the heart that loves, green represents the fertile and creative mind, blue represents the body and the blood that runs it, yellow represents the light of the soul or larger meaning.

Dotted lines represent relationships known but the child/youth feels no connection.

Arrows: No Arrows, no connections. Arrow one-way, connection felt for individual, but the connection is not shared by both individual. Arrows two-way means shared connections.

The individual can add their own meaning to the color or shape. With a Connectedness Map, the child/youth will identify people in their life who love and care about them, and who will be there for them no matter what.
