# 89th Regular Legislative Session Bills Passed

<u>SB 2165</u>, so courts can no longer dismiss a child's case just because they've gone missing or ran away.

<u>SB 1398</u>, which strengthens oversight of Community-Based Care and gives communities a formal voice in the process.

HB 4655, which expands the Preparation for Adult Living (PAL) curriculum and adds real-life financial tools like credit score education, budgeting guidance and fraud prevention — something our young adults have needed for a long time.

<u>HB 694</u> speeds up notifications to parents, CASA and other legal parties on CPS cases.

HB 1211 gives youth who have aged out of care more time — until age 27 — to lock in their tuition waiver.

HB 908 ensures law enforcement acts fast when a child goes missing.

### **CFE Tools in Action!**

"About a year ago, a CASA volunteer completed the <u>Circles of Trust</u> activity with two children first entering foster care, and at that time, they did not have many caring, supportive people in their circles.

However, the CASA volunteer recently completed the same activity with the children again, and when comparing it with the original Circles of Trust, the children were amazed! In just one year, many more people had been added! The children were so proud of how many connections they had developed over the past year. "
