October is Substance Abuse Prevention Month

Addiction is treatable but there is no one-size-fits-all approach.

Treatment can enable people to change their behavior and regain control of their lives. Successful treatment requires a personalized approach and can include evidence-based therapies and medications.

Did you know?

- More than 1 in 10 adults in the United States reported having a substance use problem.
- Among adults with a substance use problem, receiving treatment was associated with being in recovery.
- Approximately 75 percent of adults who report having a substance use problem report being in recovery.
- Having a mental health problem was highly prevalent among adults reporting a substance use problem.

The main components of recovery include:

- Treating withdrawal
- Completing treatment
- Preventing relapse


